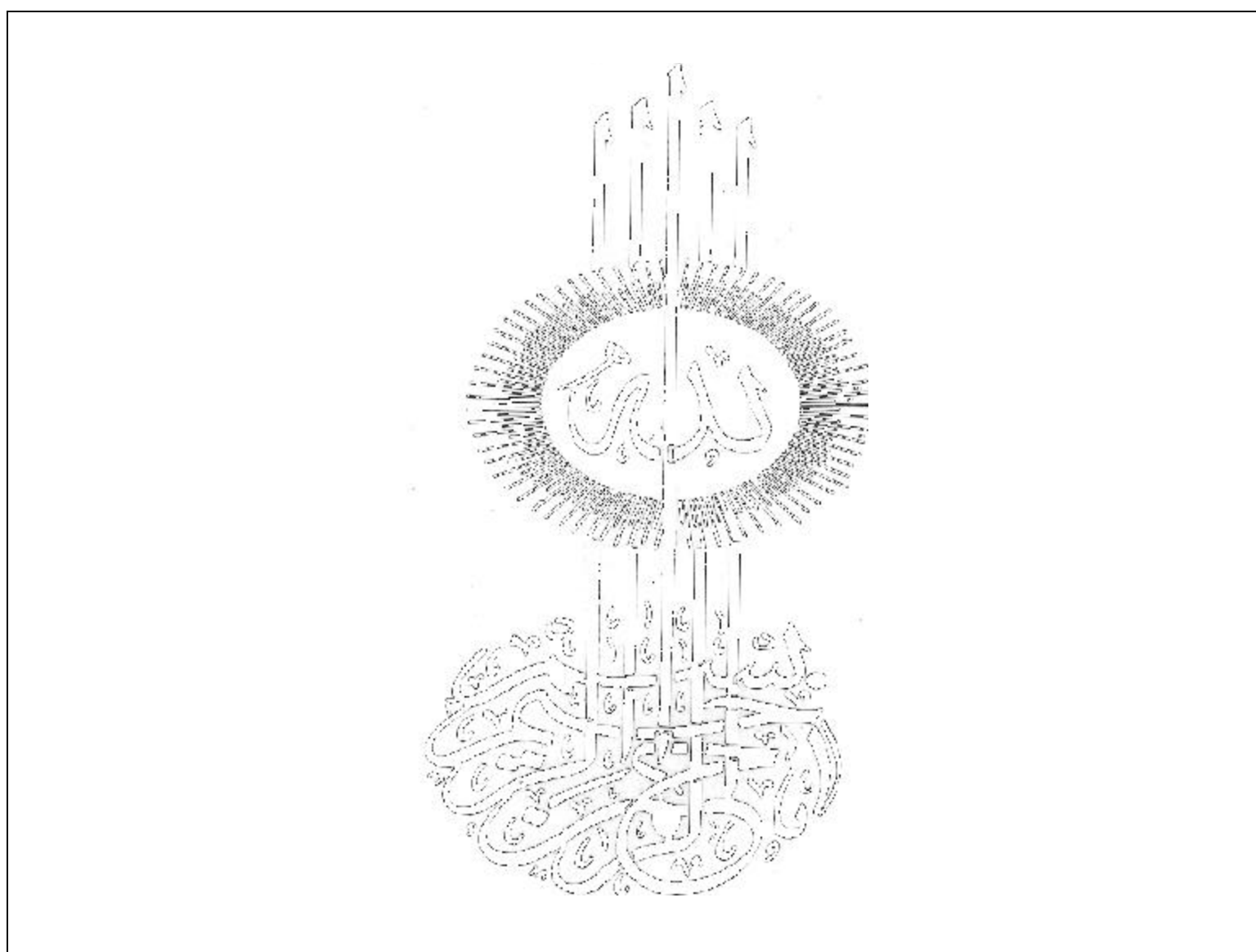

HISTORY

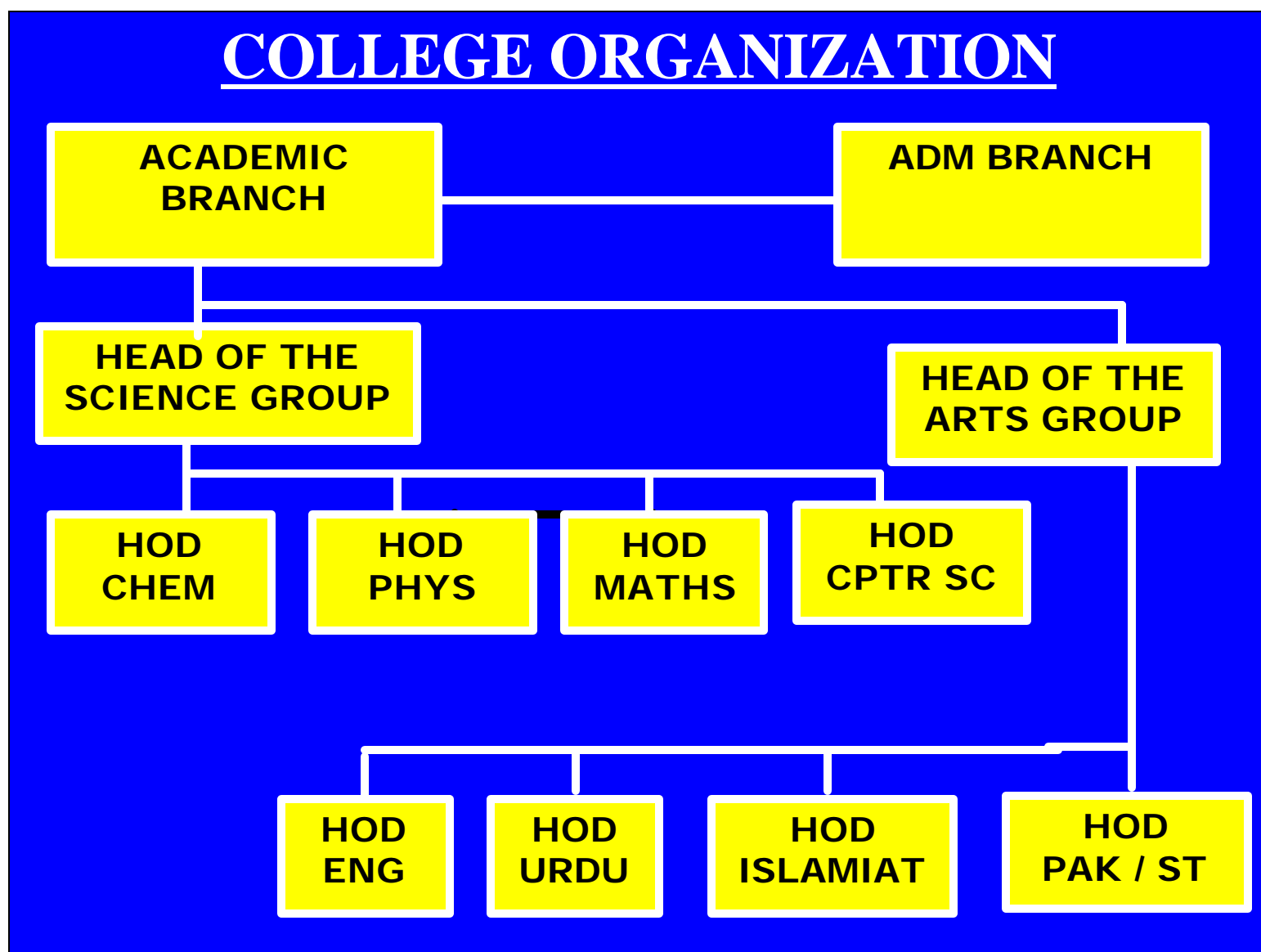
- **FOUNDED BY PRINCE OF WALES - 3rd MARCH 1922
